#### School holiday works notification - Spring | September 2023

School Infrastructure NSW regularly inspects and maintains school infrastructure as part of a comprehensive and ongoing program to keep school assets in optimal condition and ensure the safety and wellbeing of our school community across more than 2,200 NSW schools.

The school holidays are the ideal time for a lot of maintenance and project work to take place in schools across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the school holidays at some schools may involve working with hazardous materials such as asbestos or lead containing material. This may include remediation or removal of material, or sampling. This is to notify you of this work.

#### Planned work over the Spring school holidays

We will be doing work at your school that involves working with asbestos or lead containing materials **during the Spring school holidays, from the end of school on Friday 22 September to Monday 9 October 2023.** 

For information about the type of work and location within school grounds, see the listing for your school on our website: https://edu.nsw.link/HolidayWork.

Where work includes working with asbestos or lead containing material, work takes place under the advice of an independent occupational hygienist. The relevant area will be cordoned off before work starts, and safety measures and monitoring put in place.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

When the remediation work is finished, the relevant areas will be inspected by the hygienist and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is reopened for next term. If the area is part of broader work that needs to continue, the contractor will receive the clearance certificate before continuing construction.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
